**Discussion:** Susan & Steve Bean attended the Racquet Club West annual board meeting on 4.18.2024. Takeaways include:

 $\cdot$  Disaster Preparedness Training – David M. Jones – had several handouts more information available on the Red Cross website including forms for disaster planning.

• Plan on 3 trainings per year with the Red Cross at police training center

• First training in May related to extreme heat

• Two more trainings in the Fall

• Plan on inviting representatives from other NORGs to each training session

· Dementia Awareness Class – May 14<sup>th</sup>, 5:30 pm, Palm Springs Library

 Presenter – Andrea Voras, Gerontologist, Dementia Specialist (Lives in RCW)

 $\cdot$  Info on Racquet Club – Code enforcement walks the property at least once a month.

• RCW looking into removing historic designation to help with the sale of the property.

• Had to pay for \$1M liability insurance for Little Library on Yorba Road in front of Robert Farran's property.

**Social Media Discussion:** Recommendations presentation given by Steve Bean is at the end of these minutes on a separate page.

Donna Chaban suggested she would contact a previous printing vendor for graphics designed by Nat Reed to be added to the redesigned website.

Proposal requested: vote to go forward with website. Joseph made motion; Eric seconded the motion.

Steve Bean & Grant Guy to develop a prototype on Square Space.

Approval requested for up to \$500.00 for Square Space fees. Denny made motion; Cameron seconded the motion.

**New Business**: Vector control was called to check on a neighborhood pool that had been left unattended for many months and had turned dark and algae filled. Vector control responded and placed 90 mosquito fish in the pool to take care of the mosquito larvae that populated the pool.

**Donation of funds**: RCENO needs to keep \$15K in accounts. RCENO has \$15K available for donations.

Donna commented that there needs to be a 501C3 filed that requests funds and to be careful with requests.

Boys/Girls Club - \$2K original check was voided as account had been compromised. Cultural Center - \$350 for plaque Plaza Theater – donation has been made Animal Shelter - \$2K donation Fire Station – ask for equipment needs list? Community Bulletin Board – Victoria Park – Eric is to contact Parks & Recreation Disaster Kits - \$2K + \$350.00 – Joseph made motion, Denny seconded motion

<u>Old Business</u>: suggestion to increase boundaries of Racquet Club Estates for the organization to include condos on Miraleste. Denny to contact Denise Goolsby, however, Condos may be part of Vista Norta.

Little Libraries: Cameron will ask Matt if he's still willing to help repair them, up to \$300.00 has been approved for costs related to repairs.
